 You commit to raising at least \$500 and riding 25 miles at the Rodman Ride for Kids event on Saturday, May 17th in Foxboro, MA.

• 50 Mile Rider

 You commit to raising at least \$500 and riding 50 miles at the Rodman Ride for Kids event on Saturday, May 17th in Foxboro, MA

• Virtual Participant

 You already know you don't have to get on a bike to make a difference. Walk, run, ride, bake, lift, paint...whatever you enjoy, you can turn it into much-needed funds for youth programs. Your suggested fundraising minimum is \$250.

Quick Tips

- Make the first donation to your fundraising page to get the ball rolling.
- Set a fundraising goal.
- Share your story from your personal fundraising page with an image, text, and even a video.
- Connect your fundraising account to Facebook to get automatic fundraising updates. You're twice as likely to raise more by connecting your social media accounts.
- Start asking early!

DonorDrive Mobile App

- The app allows you to easily register for an event/campaign, update your fundraising story, share with friends and family, and raise money that goes directly to your charity of choice. Learn more about using the app below.
- Downloading the App (Apple iOS)
 - From the home screen of your mobile device, tap the App Store icon.
 - To browse the App Store, tap the Search icon in the bottom left corner.
 - Tap the search bar at the top of your screen.
 - Type DonorDrive into the search bar, and tap the Search button within your keyboard.
 - Tap Get next to the Donor Drive Charity Fundraising app.
 - Tap Install.
 - If prompted, sign into the App Store to complete the installation.
- Downloading the App (Android)
 - From the home screen of your mobile device, tap the Google Play Store icon.
 - To browse the Google Play Store, tap the Search bar at the top of your screen.
 - Type DonorDrive in the search bar, and tap the Search button on your keyboard.
 - Tap on the DonorDrive Charity Fundraising app thumbnail to navigate to its application page.
 - Tap Install.
 - If prompted, sign into the Google Play Store to complete the installation.
- Finding an Event or Campaign You've Registered For
 - Open the DonorDrive Charity Fundraising app from your mobile device's home screen.
 - On the Welcome screen, tap Type Short Code.
 - Type in this code in the Short Code text box: 1498-100-686
 - Tap on the Submit button.
 - Either login to your existing fundraising account or register for the event/campaign.



Incentives

- Fundraising Incentives are a tool to help you encourage donors to give and reward them for their support. You can create give away items for certain donation amounts, or maybe do an over-the-top activity for a large donation amount. For example: "For a \$20 donation, I will make you a bracelet."
- Follow Rodman for Kids on social media and be on the lookout for potential incentives and fundraising prizes!

Milestones

• Fundraising Milestones allow you to create mini-goals to inspire your donors. Donors have the option of donating directly to a milestone to help you reach your mini-goal while working towards reaching your overall fundraising goal. For example: "When I reach my \$500 milestone, I will wear a tutu on my next training ride."

QR Code

• Use the DonorDrive Mobile App to show a QR code to others to direct them to the donation form for your personal fundraising page, or team fundraising page, if applicable.

Social Media

• Grow your fundraising with Facebook! Did you know the average Facebook Fundraiser raises at least \$150? With a Facebook Fundraiser, you can raise money directly on Facebook to help you reach your fundraising goal!

Work
